


The course has been created for teachers who want to acquire knowledge about using social media as an educational tool, enhance student engagement and improve communication between students and teachers.

# Main Course Locations



It is a very green city: 1/3 of the city is made up of forests, parks, gardens rivers and lakes, where Berliners as well as the tourists enjoy the contact with nature all year around.





It is one of the most beautiful towns in the area of the Argolis Gulf in eastern Peloponnese as well as one of the most romantic cities all over Greece. Most of the old town is on a peninsula which forms a natural protected bay. It was the first capital of the Greek state between 1823 and 1834. According to mythology, the town was founded by Náfplios, the son of god Poseidon and the daughter of Danaus (Danaida) Anymone.
